PETTING FARM /CHILDREN'S ZOO

HEALTH & SAFETY

S1 Preventative Interventions – Review suitability of H&S inductions, ongoing training provision, PPE provision, guarding and separation of animals and visitors, warning signs etc

S2 Managing Occ. Health - Review suitability of H&S inductions, ongoing training provision, specific risk training – e.g. manual handling, PPE provision, risk of zoonose infections etc

S3 Audit of high risk processes – any high risk process – animal handling, tractor driving etc etc

S4 Interface of H&S with the public - on farm/car park vehicle movements , guarding and separation of animals and visitors, animal/tractor rides, storage of equipment/chemicals etc

S5 Determining the effectiveness of SMS – audit existing Risk Assessments against practice

S6 – Work related illness – audit of sickness reports - cross ref to S2

S7 Accident Investigation - investigation of any accident (Reportable or non reportable)

FOOD

F5 – Audit of food premises – On site cafe/restaurant/ ice cream stands etc

F4 - Fitness of Food – Audit of delivery checks on food to F5 facilities/ of home produced food offered for sale to public – eggs, honey, meat/meat products etc

F6 -Food Standards – Compliance checks on home produced food offered for sale to public – eggs, honey, meat/meat products etc
