Designation: Student Environmental Health Officer

Grade: Unpaid Placement

Organisational Responsibility: Responsible to the Student Training Officer.

Job Purpose: To train as an Environmental Health Officer under the supervision of qualified Officers.

Major Tasks:

1. To be enrolled on or have completed a relevant degree programme in Environmental Health at a CIEH accredited University, and to undertake a period of practical training that will lead to the completion on the Experiential Learning Portfolio.
2. To carry out such training both in the workplace, as deemed appropriate by the trainee's nominated officer and by the training establishment.
3. To assist Technical Staff and Environmental Health Officers in the enforcement of Public Health, Environmental Protection, Housing, Food Safety, Health and Safety and other related legislation.
4. To carry out enforcement duties under the supervision of a nominated Environmental Health Officer.
5. To carry, maintain and operate the equipment of the Division under the supervision of Environmental Health Officers.
6. To attend Court to provide evidence and corroborative evidence when required.
